

Student Reduced Transit Fares

Guidelines for After School Matters teens

Summer 2016 program session

If you have a CPS student reduced fare card and get the reduced fare during the school year:

- Make sure you have your correct CPS ID# on file with After School Matters by the first week of programs. You will then continue to get the CPS student reduced fare throughout your Summer 2016 program session.

If you do NOT have a CPS student reduced fare card (and you are a CPS student):

- You will need to contact your school directly about purchasing a CPS student reduced fare card. WE RECOMMEND YOU DO THIS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, as many schools will not be able to provide these after the school year ends.
- Once you have the card, you will need to make sure your CPS ID# is on file with After School Matters by the first week of programs. You will then get the CPS student reduced fare throughout your Summer 2016 program session.

If you do NOT have a CPS student reduced fare card (and you are NOT a CPS student)

- You will need to contact your school directly about options to get reduced transit fares over the summer.

****PLEASE NOTE:*** While we are able to provide access to student reduced fares for teens who already have a student transit card, After School Matters does not have access to the cards themselves. We are also not able to provide access to student reduced fares for teens who attend non-CPS or charter schools. Graduated seniors are not eligible to receive the student reduced fare.
