# I-9 Employment Verification for Teen Interns

## **BEFORE YOU START YOUR PROGRAM:**

Teens must complete the Form I-9 Employment Eligibility Verification before you start your program. After accepting your internship offer, you are required to attend an in-person verification meeting where you will present specific identity confirming documentation to complete the verification process. **Documents must be original and unexpired.** 

To learn which documents to bring with you for the in-person verification meeting, please see the complete list of acceptable documents on page two of the Form I-9 Employment Eligibility Verification here.

## **Obtaining a Social Security Card:**

If you don't have one, you can apply for one <u>here</u>; or search for a Chicago-area Social Security Administration office near you using tool.

To apply for a Social Security Card:

- Find your birth certificate + ONE Evidence of Identity (i.e. Driver's License, State ID, etc.)
- Print and fill out Social Security Application
- Apply online, in-person, or by mail

### **Obtaining a State ID:**

If you do not have a State ID, you can apply for one here.

- Schedule an appointment at Department of Motor Vehicles.
  - You must bring documents such as your Social Security Card and Birth Certificate. Your documents must verify your:
    - Signature
    - Date Of Birth
    - SSN
    - Proof of residency
