Did you know you need a valid form of Identification to open a bank account? Check out if the Real ID is right for you!

What is the Real ID?

A REAL ID is a driver's license or ID card that is also a federally accepted form of identification. REAL ID cards have a star in the upper-right hand corner-right corner.

Beginning May 7, 2025, the federal government will require every person 18 years and older to present a REAL ID-compliant state-issued driver's license or ID card or another acceptable form of identification — like a valid U.S. passport — to board a flight within the U.S. or enter a secure federal building.

Real ID Checklist:

- Documents must be valid
- Only original hard copies are accepted
- Printed electronic documents can be used (e.g., bank statements)
- All account numbers must be clearly visible
- No photocopies are allowed
